

Getting Started Setting Up Your eBay Account

Hello and welcome to the first training video. As I've mentioned before this process is really simple just follow the directions I'm about to give you and you'll be on your way to selling your first item.

The first thing you need to do is set up your ebay account.

Go to eBay.com. Click on the register link in the upper right hand corner of the screen.

Then on the next page fill in the form fields with the correct information. Enter your first name, last name, email address, password and then click "create account."

You can also use your Facebook or Google account to sign up with eBay.

Once you do that, you're good to go.

Now, before you list your first item to sell, eBay will ask you for your street address and your phone number. Just enter that information and you'll be able to list your first item.

Now, before we get into where and how to find the "junk" that you'll spin into gold on eBay, let's first talk about what I recommend that you do first.

And that is to find some stuff around your house or apartment that you don't want or you don't use anymore and sell that first. Now, why would we want to do that? Well, first of all, because it's free. And it's easy. And you can use the profits from selling those items to fund additional items to sell. I always recommend that you reinvest in your business as much as you can so you can grow it faster.

Okay, so what should you be looking for to sell from around your home? You want to look for video games, video game systems, clothes, tvs, smart phones, shoes, toys bags, bookbags, purses, luggage, small appliances, computer equipment, collectibles (comic books, baseball cards, vintage toys).

Now you may notice that the things I'm recommending are smaller items. I like to sell smaller items like toys, clothes, and smartphones because they sell well and they're very easy to ship. Shipping large items like furniture or large appliances is a big pain in the butt and it is cost prohibitive meaning it costs a boatload to ship. And that's why I don't recommend that you sell large items.

If you don't have anything from your home that you want to sell, don't worry. In a later video I reveal some secret places I always go to literally find junk that I spin into gold on eBay.
